Endowed Scholarship Funds

Brant Bruhn Memorial Scholarship

The purpose of this fund is to provide a scholarship to Muscatine High School graduating seniors planning to attend post secondary education in the state of Iowa, and whom have participated at least one year in a high school sanctioned sport.

Bruce C. Heezen Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to MHS graduating seniors based on scholarship, financial need, good moral character, willingness to work and assume responsibility. This scholarship is renewable for up to 4 years so long as the students remains in good standing.

Class of 1953 Scholarship

This scholarship is available to MHS graduating seniors exhibiting strong motivation and work ethic.

Class of 1956 Scholarship

This scholarship is available to MHS graduating seniors exhibiting strong motivation and work ethic.

Dianne R. Dalbey Memorial Scholarship

The purpose of this fund is to make scholarships available to Muscatine High School seniors who wish to pursue careers as an emergency medical technician as a Nationally Registered Paramedic or its State of Iowa equivalent, Paramedic Specialist, or a career in nursing.

Elaine May YMCA Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who participated in swimming, track or golf and maintained a cumulative 3.000 GPA or better.

Elvira Trevarthen Scholarship

The intent of this scholarship is “to make an award to a deserving student who might not otherwise have the opportunity to attend college if the scholarship were not available.”

Flickinger Learning Center Scholarship

The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships to Muscatine High School graduating students who attended programming at the center and will pursue post-secondary education within Iowa.

Fosholt Scholarship in Engineering or Architecture

This scholarship is for MHS graduating seniors in pursuit of an engineering or architecture degree at Muscatine Community College, Iowa State University or the University of Iowa. Scholarship (3.000 GPA or better), character, leadership and activities will be taken into consideration. This scholarship is renewable for up to 4 years so long as the student remains in good standing.

Francis & Patricia Carroll Scholarship

A fund to provide scholarships for Louisa-Muscatine students.

Hall of Honor Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a MHS student demonstrating strong citizenship, has participated in extracurricular activities and maintains a 3.000 GPA minimum.

Harold and Corrine Marx Scholarship

This scholarship is available to MHS graduating seniors with a preference given to those planning to attend a technical or trade school. In the event no applicant meets those criteria, a graduate pursuing a degree in nursing or education will receive the award.

Jim and Arlene Kaeding Memorial Scholarship

Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA, be active in athletic activities and plan to enter the field of education. Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation from MHS teachers or coaches in which they discuss the applicant's character in at least one of the following areas: youth focused community service, work ethic, problem solving, love of learning, trustworthiness or patience.

Julia Wojtecki Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who have participated in the instrumental music program for 3 of 4 years, are looking to attend an eastern Iowa Community College (preferable MCC), maintain a 2.000 GPA and have no other scholarship with a value of over \$1,000.

Larry Fullington Memorial Endowment

Honoring Larry Fullington's life and benefiting athletic students graduating from Muscatine High School.

Leah L. Maurer Memorial Scholarship

The purpose of the fund is to honor the memory of Leah and to provide annual grants to Education Research Foundation, Inc. for Sylvan Learning Scholarships in Leah L. Maurer's name.

Marie C. Ruthenburg Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who are in pursuit of a teaching career. It is given in memory of Marie C. Ruthenburg, who served as an educator in the Muscatine School System for over 50 years.

Matthew B. Seligman Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who actively demonstrate community involvement entering the field of engineering.

Max A. Collins Sr. Scholarship

Sponsored by the Elks' Chanters, this scholarship is for an MHS student pursuing a major in music or who will continue music participation in their future communities.

Micaela L. Brunson Memorial Scholarship Fund

This fund has been established in memory of Micaela Brunson to provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from Muscatine High School whom plans to attend post-secondary education in the field of a helping profession. Such as, but not limited to, pre-medical, nursing, teaching or counseling. The student will also demonstrate volunteer experience during their high school career.

Muscatine County Soil and Water Conservation District's Ralph L. Kirchner Memorial Scholarship Endowment

The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships for post high school education for those who wish to pursue a career in agriculture.

Muscatine High School General Scholarships

This scholarship is available to MHS graduating seniors with preference given to those demonstrating a willingness to take on challenging coursework throughout his/her high school career.

Muscatine Masquers Theater Scholarship Endowment for MCC

After many years of providing community theater in Muscatine County, the Muscatine Masquers organization dissolved. Their legacy is a theater scholarship for Muscatine Community College students active in theater. Scholarship information and criteria are available from MCC.

Patricia Coss Memorial Scholarship

Special consideration will be given to MHS graduating seniors who attended Madison Elementary School or who have demonstrated the ability to overcome adversity.

Roach Scholarships

Two scholarship awards are available to MHS graduating seniors who have maintained a 3.000 GPA throughout high school and possess qualities of citizenship, leadership, services and are of high moral character. A third scholarship will be awarded to a post-secondary scholar in pursuit of a Business degree maintaining a 3.000 GPA in all course and 3.500 GPA in business coursework. This applicant must have already taken at least three (3) full-year courses in business to qualify.

Robert P. Herwig Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans to attend MCC and pursue a career in education. The scholarship is presented in honor of Robert P. Herwig who served as a teacher, coach and administrator in the Muscatine Community School District for over 35 years.

Robert W. and Dorothy M. Toborg Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who exhibit leadership, good moral character, citizenship, high school and community involvement and have an unmet financial need.

Whetstine Family Endowment Fund

The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships for post-secondary education and youth camps to members of the United Methodist Church in Wilton, IA.

Wulf Family Scholarship

This fund has been established in memory of Helen P. Wulf to provide a scholarship to a graduating senior from Muscatine High School or Louisa-Muscatine High School whom plans to attend post-secondary education in a health-related field of study which will lead to a professional certificate or degree upon completion.
