Unendowed Scholarship Funds

Class of 1974 Scholarship

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a senior planning to attend any accredited college, junior college, or technical school. GPA is not a critical factor, but the applicant should show strong motivation and work ethic.

Class of 1984 Scholarship

One scholarship, given by the graduating class of 1984, is worth \$200. The scholarship may be used at any accredited college or university. The recipient to be in top 1/3 of class academically and must have participated in at least two extracurricular/sports during their senior year.

Class of 1993 Scholarship (Acorn Endowment)

This scholarship will be available to MHS graduating seniors exhibiting strong motivation, work ethic, character, leadership, community involvement and a desire to further their education. Preference will be given to those looking to attend college within the state of Iowa.

Don and Dorothy Platt Scholarship

This scholarship has been established by Don and Dorothy Platt in honor of Dorothy Platt, a retired Muscatine elementary teacher. The scholarship will recognize a student who plans to pursue a career in elementary education and has maintained a 3.000 GPA.

Dr. John W. Watson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who demonstrate strong motivation, work ethic, participate in extracurricular activities and have an unmet financial need. Preference will be given to applicants in pursuit of a teaching career.

Dr. Russell N. Ward Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS on basis of capabilities and financial need as a memorial to Dr. Ward, former Superintendent of Schools. The scholarship may be used at any accredited college.

Ed Ware Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who has demonstrated strong leadership abilities, good character, and participation in school activities.

Ellen Fessler Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to MHS graduating seniors in pursuit of a major in education. Preference will be given to those looking to graduate with a physical education degree and those having attended Washington, Garfield or Franklin Elementary Schools.

Frank & Carrie Townsend and Ruth Townsend Scholarship Fund

This scholarship provides several scholarships to Wilton High School graduates.

Gerald Garvin Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to MHS graduating seniors looking to attend Muscatine Community College (MCC). Preference will be given to students who participated in band during their high school career and have an unmet financial need.

Graciela (Coca) V. Page Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is in support of the post-secondary education for a Latina graduating senior from MHS in honor of Graciela (Coca).

H.J. Heinz Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who must have a minimum 2.500 GPA, demonstrate citizenship and an unmet financial need. Preference will be given to those who have been active in various co-curricular activities and is a child or grandchild of an active Heinz employee.

Jeanette Phillips Crossroads Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who intends to attend an accredited 2 or 4 - year college in pursuit of a career working with the people in the mentally or physically challenged community, has experience in community activities, maintains a 3.000 cumulative GPA or above and has an unmet financial need.

Krieger Food & Nutrition Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who elects to pursue a career in food & nutrition. If no applicants apply a field of nursing will be considered.

Krieger Technical Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who elects to pursue a technical career.

League of Women Voters of Muscatine Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who are of “good character with the potential for scholarship and/or leadership in a chosen field.” Preference will be given to a female student followed by a student with financial need.

Matthew B. Seligman Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who attends any 2-year or 4-year college, demonstrates community involvement and who are entering the field of engineering.

Maurice and Donna Reed Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who plan to pursue a degree in Science demonstrating some financial need. If no qualified applications are received preference will then be given to a student with intentions to pursue a degree in education.

Mente Fellowship of Christian Athletes Scholarship

Available to MHS FCA members with FCA participation, leadership, athletic participation, scholastic achievement and financial need taken into consideration.

Patricia Coss Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who are attending any 2 or 4 year college. Special consideration will be given to students who attended Madison Elementary or students who have demonstrated the ability to overcome adversity.

Paul Satterthwaite Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS in memory of Paul Satterthwaite, a World War II POW and life-long Muscatine resident. Preference will be given to any student interested in a career with youth or adults with special needs.

Robert Jasper Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who will be attending the Muscatine Community College (MCC).

Robert Nietzel Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who is planning to further his/her education at any accredited post-secondary school. Financial need, good character and citizenship, and a desire to further his/her education are the factors to be used for selecting the recipient.

Robert and JoAnn Jensen GMG Schools Foundation Scholarships

This fund supports three annual and renewable scholarships for graduates of Garwin High School.

Ruth Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS to be used at any accredited institution.

Stephen Luth Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS Christian who lives by the ideals of his or her faith. The recipient is one who is spiritually alive, exhibits a high moral standard, enjoys helping people, leads by example and with humility through volunteer experience, and church activities. The applicant must have been involved in high school sports all four years with a preference given to those who participated in Cross Country or Track with plans to attend a 4-year college or university.

Temp Associates & RJK, Inc Scholarship Fund for Louisa-Muscatine Schools

This fund was created by Robert and JoAnn Jensen to benefit Louisa County youth through scholarships. Applicants who demonstrate good character, citizenship, an unmet financial need, pursue continued studies within the state of Iowa as a full-time student at an accredited college or university and maintain a 2.000 GPA or better are eligible for a renewable scholarship for up to four consecutive years.

Temp Associates & RJK, Inc Scholarship Fund for Muscatine Schools

This fund was created by Robert and JoAnn Jensen to benefit Muscatine County youth through scholarships. This scholarship is available to graduating seniors of MHS who intends to pursue a career in education and/or a degree in foreign language.

Virginia Lorimor Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is available to female graduating seniors of MHS who were a cross-country or track participant. They must demonstrate leadership skills, team spirit and pride.

West Middle School Scholarship (Go M.A.D.)

West Middle School 8th grade students have established a scholarship that will be presented to at least one student who attended West Middle School and are now currently attending Muscatine Schools. The scholarship can be used at any post-secondary institution upon graduating from high school.
